Dear friends!

The return of the Holy shout, "Alleluia," is testimony to the power and work of Jesus Christ, who sustains us in darkest times; while His own dark times are changed in a twinkling of the eye: He who goes down in death is suddenly flooded with light and energy, in the transformation of life into an eternal state of victory and peace.
