#### **Holy Trinity Church Financial Report: 1st Quarter 2018**

The 1st quarter of 2018 ended March 31st, and we are in a stable financial position.

- On the income side pledges are behind \$2,200 after correcting for pre-paid pledges.
- On the expense side Church Repair/Maintenance is over budget primarily due to snow removal and a plumbing repair from 2017 paid in 2018. The oil tank was filled in February to take advantage of a good price on oil so that line is overbudget. The insurance line will be under budget until it is paid in December, but funds are held in reserve for this payment.
- For their 60th birthday celebration Susan Grant and Tamsin Lucey asked that donations be made to the Holy Trinity Building Fund; it was a grand party and the Building Fund grew by \$3,300.
