Creation Care Corner We are called to do what is right, even if it requires more effort.

November 8 is the LAST day stores in Southbridge will be able to give you a plastic bag to take your shopping home. The town has adopted a by-law banning the use of plastic shopping bags. So... be prepared to use paper bags or, even better, bring your own re-useable bag. For the month of July, Big Y Supermarkets will donate \$1 toward food insecurity – if YOU choose Holy Trinity Church, we will direct the funds to Food Share. Stop & Shop will also allow you to direct a \$1 DONATION to Holy Trinity Church that we will forward to Food Share. That program is year-round. Be prepared! Re-useable bags from grocery stores cost \$2.50, less than a take out coffee, snack or meal. FYI—Canada recently approved banning ALL plastic straws, plastic stirrers, and Q-tips with plastic stems by 2021. YOU can make a difference NOW by choosing not to use a plastic straw or to buy Q-tips with paper stems. Just Do It.
