Requirements: A qualified nominee for church office is, by Canon Law, a “confirmed adult communicant of the Church in good standing.” “Good standing” is taken to mean having participated in the life of the parish in the last year, contributed to its support, been regular in attendance at worship and received communion at least three times in the past year. “Adult” is taken to mean over age 16. There is an expectation that all in ministries of leadership understand the need for thoughtful, prayerful discernment in decision-making.
